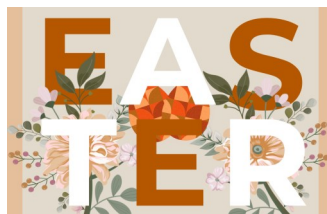

We were thick in the process of showing the facility to local churches who were interested, we were planning our move-in days in our current location, and doing a lot of praying. What a long way we’ve come.

Campbell family and friends, I think it’s accurate to say that we’ve experienced a whirlwind of change over this past year. But through it all, we know one thing with crystal assurance – our God has been with us! Every day I give God thanks to be blessed in serving with you as your pastor – I don’t know if I can adequately express how amazing you all are.
