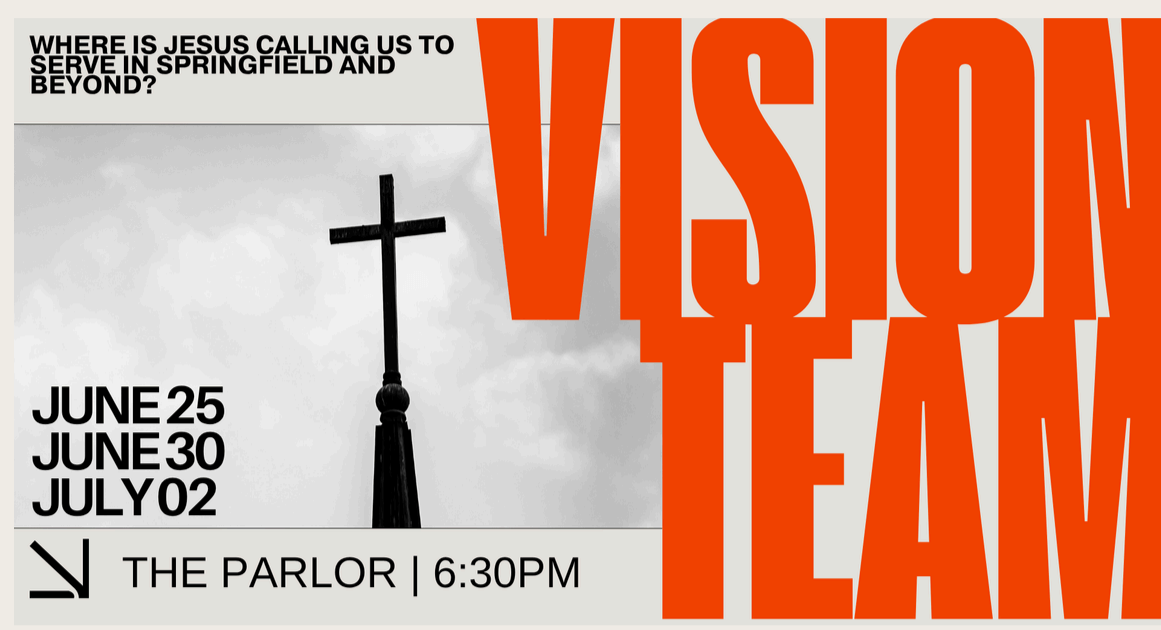



Volunteer with us at Crosslines Food Pantry to support the food insecure in our community every fourth Thursday.


